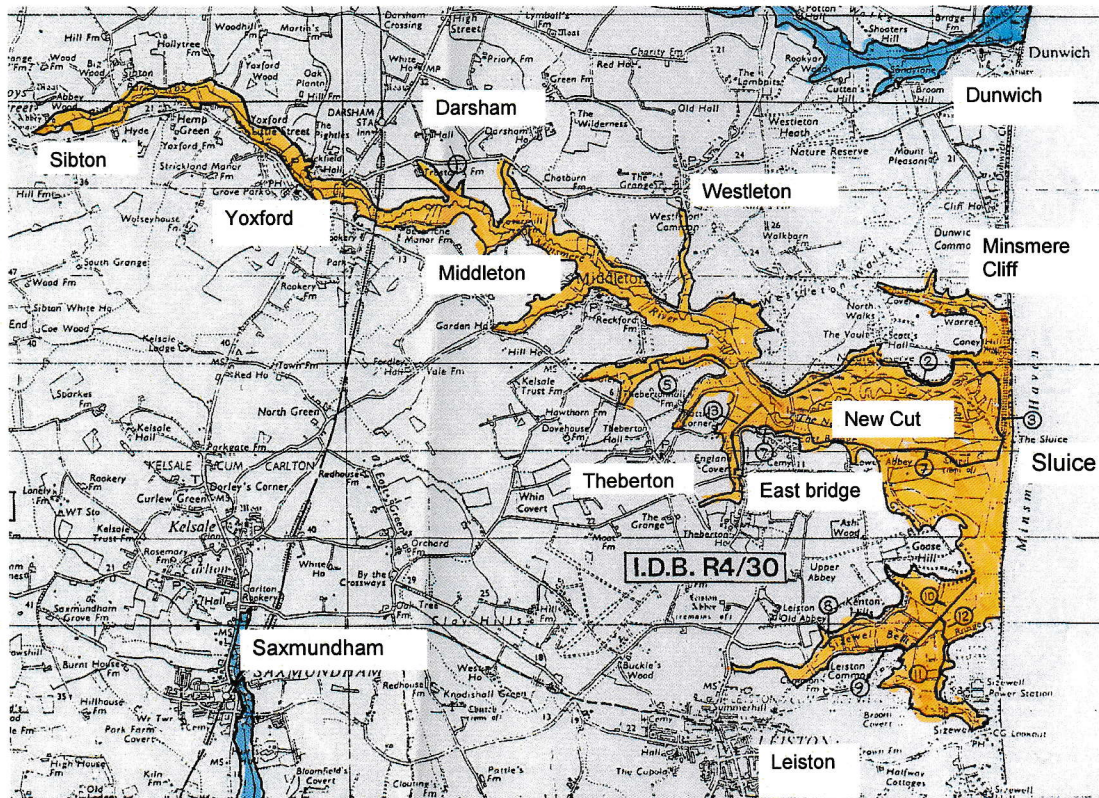

1. Minsmere Internal Drainage District coverage:



2. Major Problems :

1. Fresh water flooding.
2. Blockage of sluice.
3. Coastal erosion.

3. Main Topics for Minsmere Levels Stakeholder Group :

1. Discussions with IDB to ensure routine maintenance of ditches and land drains. Involve major landowners in co-operative discussions.
2. Establishing links with conservation bodies to explore common interests on managements of water levels and protection of our coast
3. Negotiations with Environment Agency to ensure that the New Cut and Sluice are maintained in the medium term, and that action taken if e.g. blocked by shingle. Install water pump at sluice?
4. Encouragement of a long term strategy for managed re-alignment if necessary along the shingle bar from Minsmere Cliffs to Sizewell. Negotiate with national bodies, Environment Agency etc., re 'sensible action' on Shore-line Management Plan.
